Dear colleagues,

We are pleased to invite you to the conference **“From Soil to Systems: Living Labs and Artificial Intelligence for a Sustainable Future of Agriculture”**, which will take place in Brussels on **13 October 2026**.

The event, organised by the **Polish Science Contact Agency PolSCA of the Polish Academy of Sciences**, the **Committee of Agronomic Sciences of the Polish Academy of Sciences** and the **University of Florence**, will focus on soil and plant health, and their role in the future of European agriculture.

Starting from the EU Mission **“A Soil Deal for Europe”**, the conference will look at how research, policy and practice can meet around healthier soils, more resilient farming systems and more sustainable food production. Particular attention will be given to **Living Labs**, understood not as a policy slogan, but as practical spaces for testing solutions together with farmers, researchers, businesses, public authorities and local communities. The programme will also address **artificial intelligence and the growing role of data in agriculture**, including their potential to support soil and crop monitoring, precision farming and better decision-making.

The conference will be organized back-to-back with the international brokerage event for selected topics under Cluster 6 of Horizon Europe, which will take place on 12 October 2026 in Brussels.
